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Three key issues discussed/agreed at the meeting and their impact on the Third Sector (if any)

- **Public Health White Paper & changes surrounding NHS** - currently the NHS is going through a 2 year transitional period; (creation of 'Public Health England', health funding going to local authorities, etc) the restructuring could mean opportunities for the third sector
- **6 PCTs including Greenwich are being merged into one organisation** 1st April this year. In their place more streamlined 6 borough support units- whose role amongst others is to set up GP consortiums
- **JSNA -Joint Strategic Needs Assessment** (A borough health needs assessment which informs the Greenwich H&WB Strategy) remains a high priority for this sub-board. Priorities are care groups and geographical focus. A refresh will take place in June 2011. Not sure if those refreshing are engaging with carers orgs?
